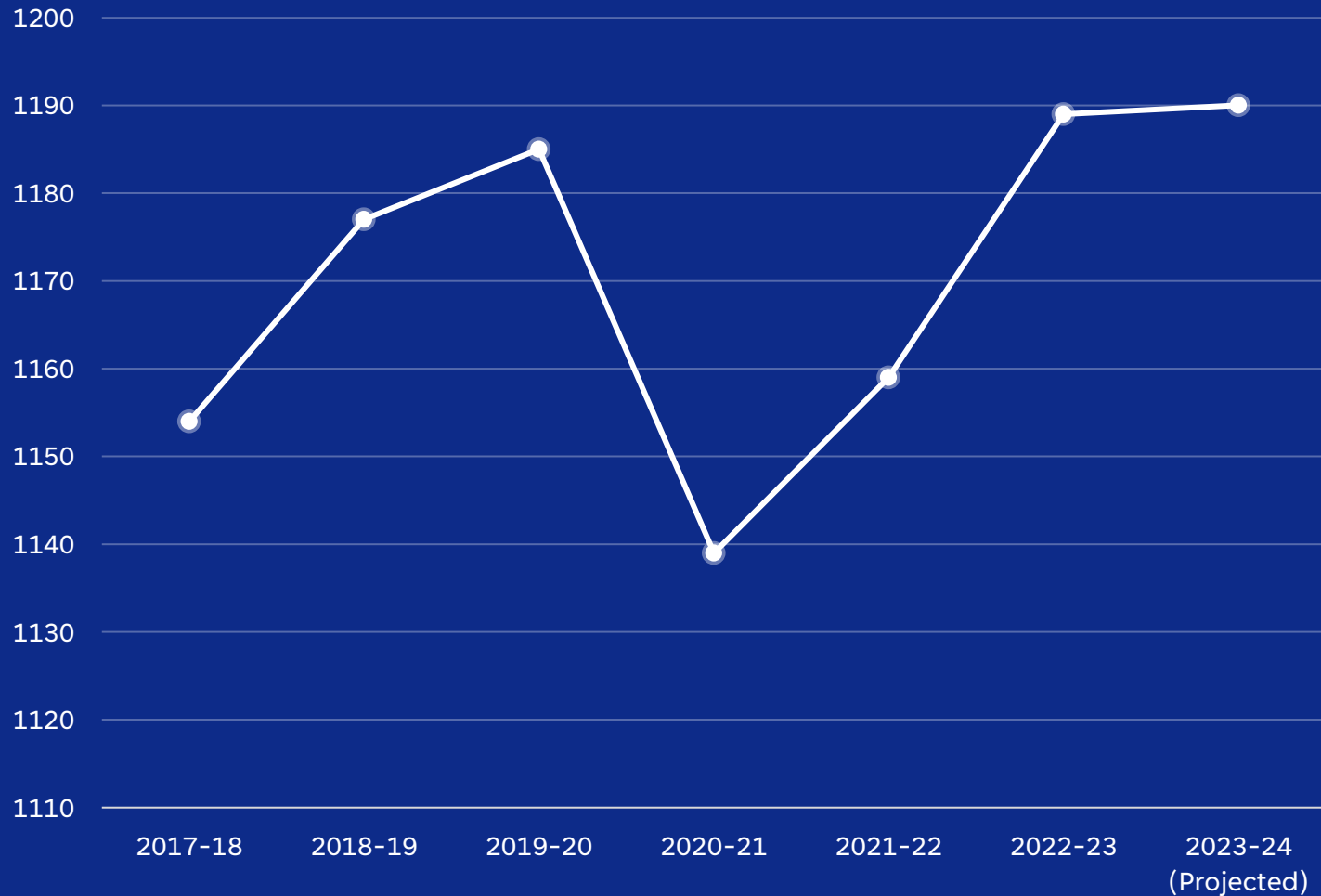
Vision
